#### SUBMITTING ENTRIES

We welcome exhibits in the Children's classes from everyone under 16! You do not have to be a member of the society to exhibit. Entries are FREE! Exhibitors may only have one entry per class.

Entries can be submitted until **7pm** on <u>Wednesday 13th September</u>. There are two methods of submitting entries:

For children's entries, please ensure the child's name and age is added to the entry form, along with a responsible adult's details.

#### JUDGING

The name of the judge for each section can be found above each list of classes. The hall must be cleared by **10:15am** on the morning of the show to allow judging to commence promptly at 10:30am. During the judging, only judges and stewards will be allowed in the hall.

#### PRIZE MONEY, TROPHIES & AWARDS

In each class, the winning entry will be awarded **60p** prize money, the second place entry **40p** and the third place **20p** 

Prize money can be collected from the treasurer between 2pm and 4:30pm on the afternoon of the show. Prize money not collected before the close of the show will be treated as a donation to the Society.

The following trophies are also awarded at the show. Each winner will be presented with a certificate during the prize giving around 4pm.
